# Microsoft Word 2007 – Checking for disabled Add-ins

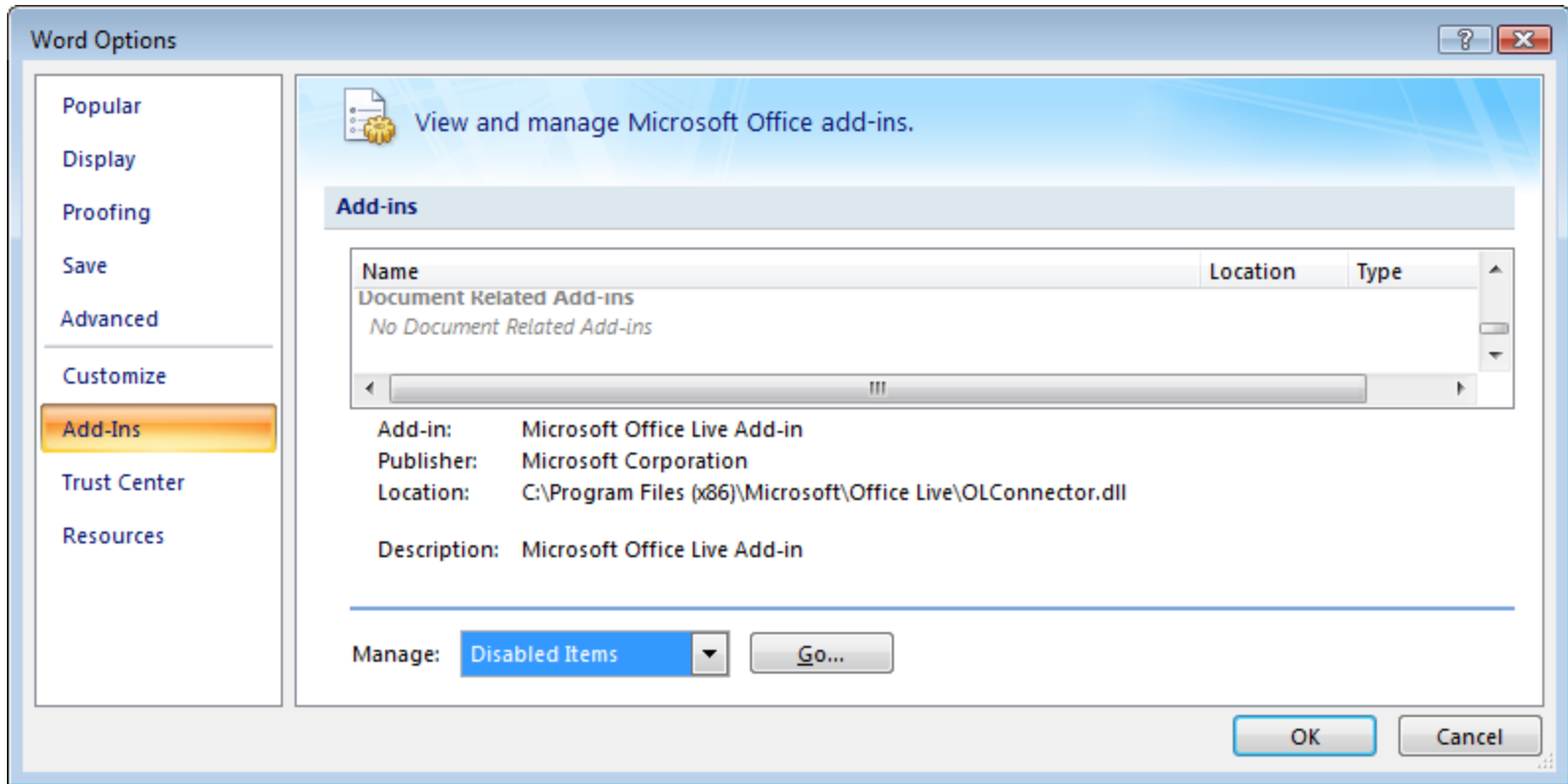
Click on the Microsoft Office button the click on the “Word Options” button
